
Do you see a *p* for *Piano*? Count the Quarter Notes quietly. Clap quietly too. Count "1, 2, 3, 4" for the Quarter Notes with a quiet voice.

Quarter Notes

Do you see an *f* for *Forté*? Count the Quarter Notes loudly. Clap loud too. Count "1, 2, 3, 4" for the Quarter Notes with a loud voice.
