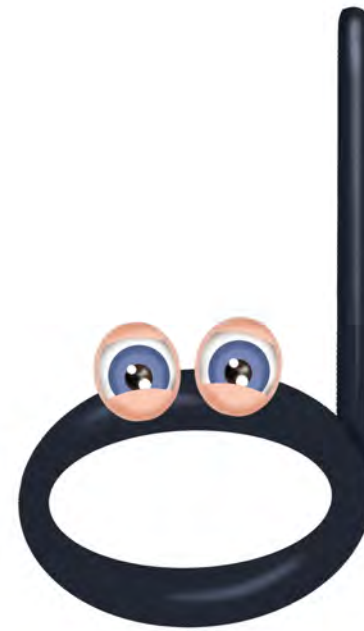
Half Notes

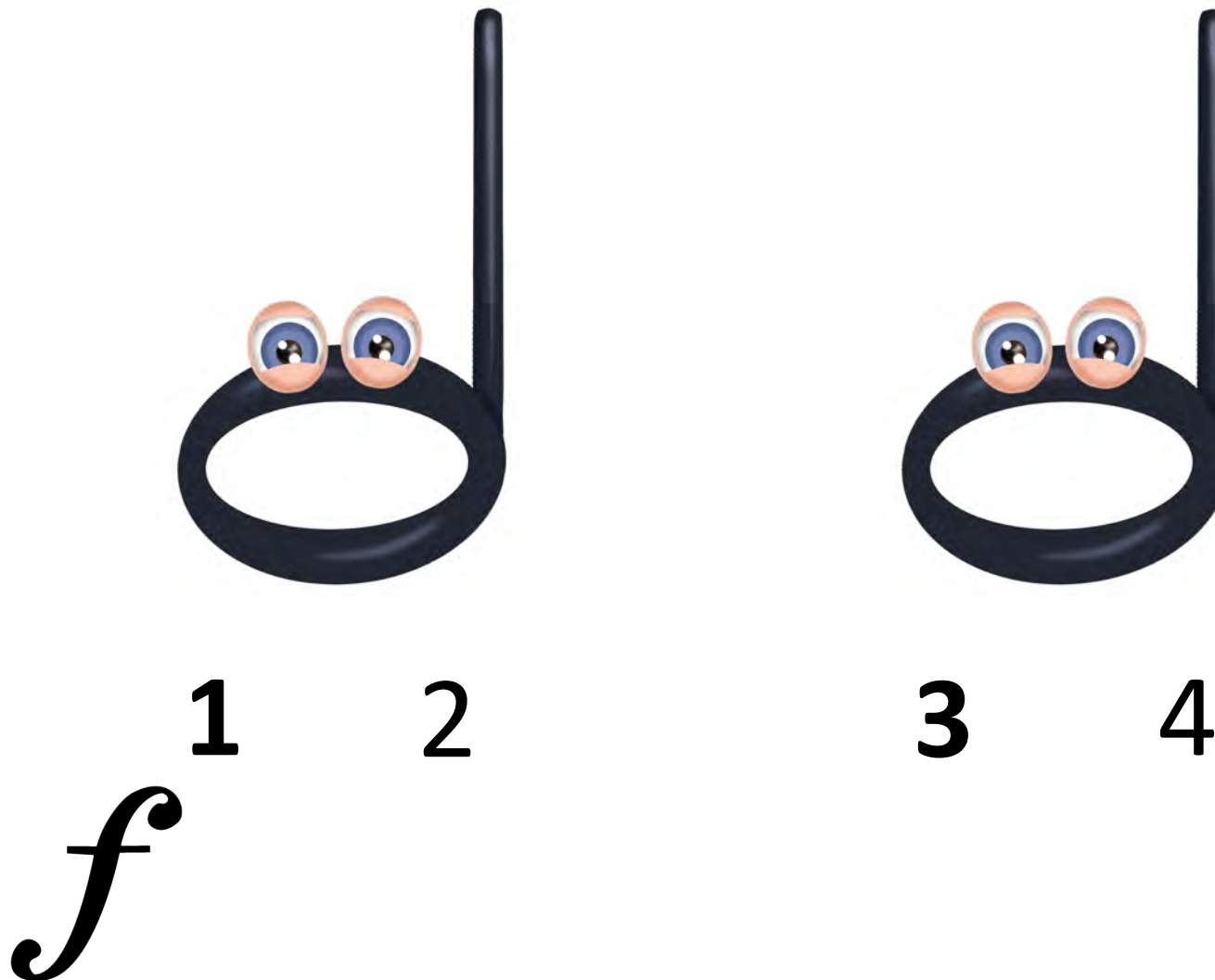

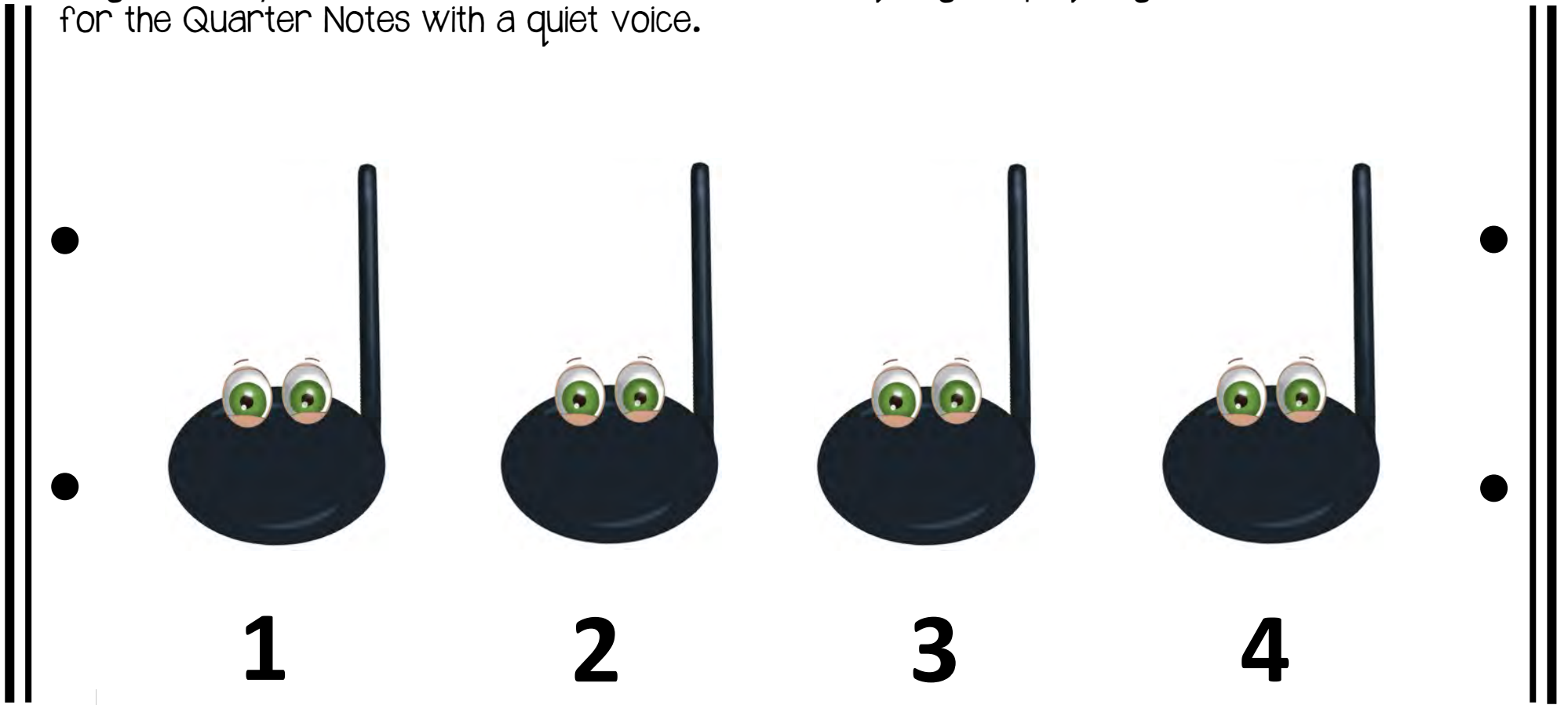
Half Notes

Quarter Notes



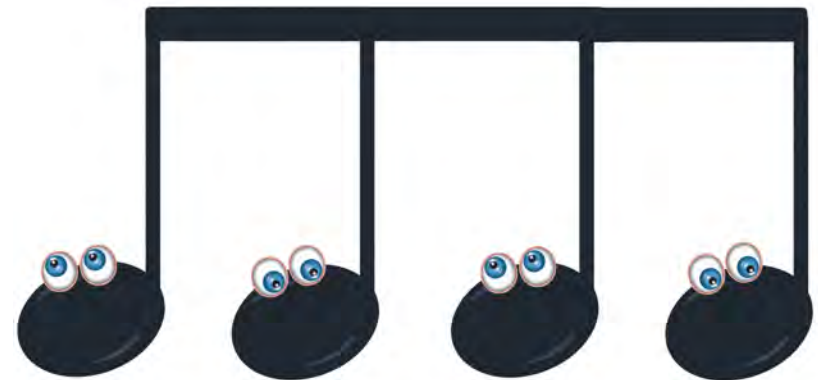
